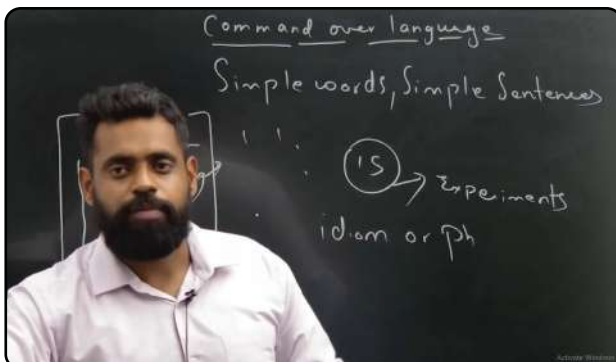
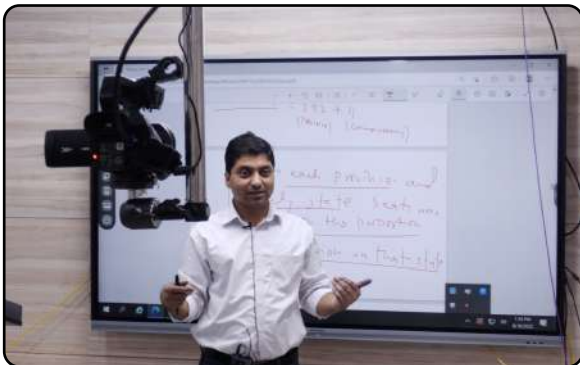

The Civil Services Examination (CSE) is a national competitive examination in India conducted by the Union Public Service Commission for recruitment to higher Civil Services of the Government of India, including the Indian Administrative Service, Indian Foreign Service, Indian Police Service, and other allied services. In simple terms, it is referred as the UPSC examination. These are mentioned under Article 315 of our constitution. Every year UPSC notifies examination of civil services. This consist of Three Stages-

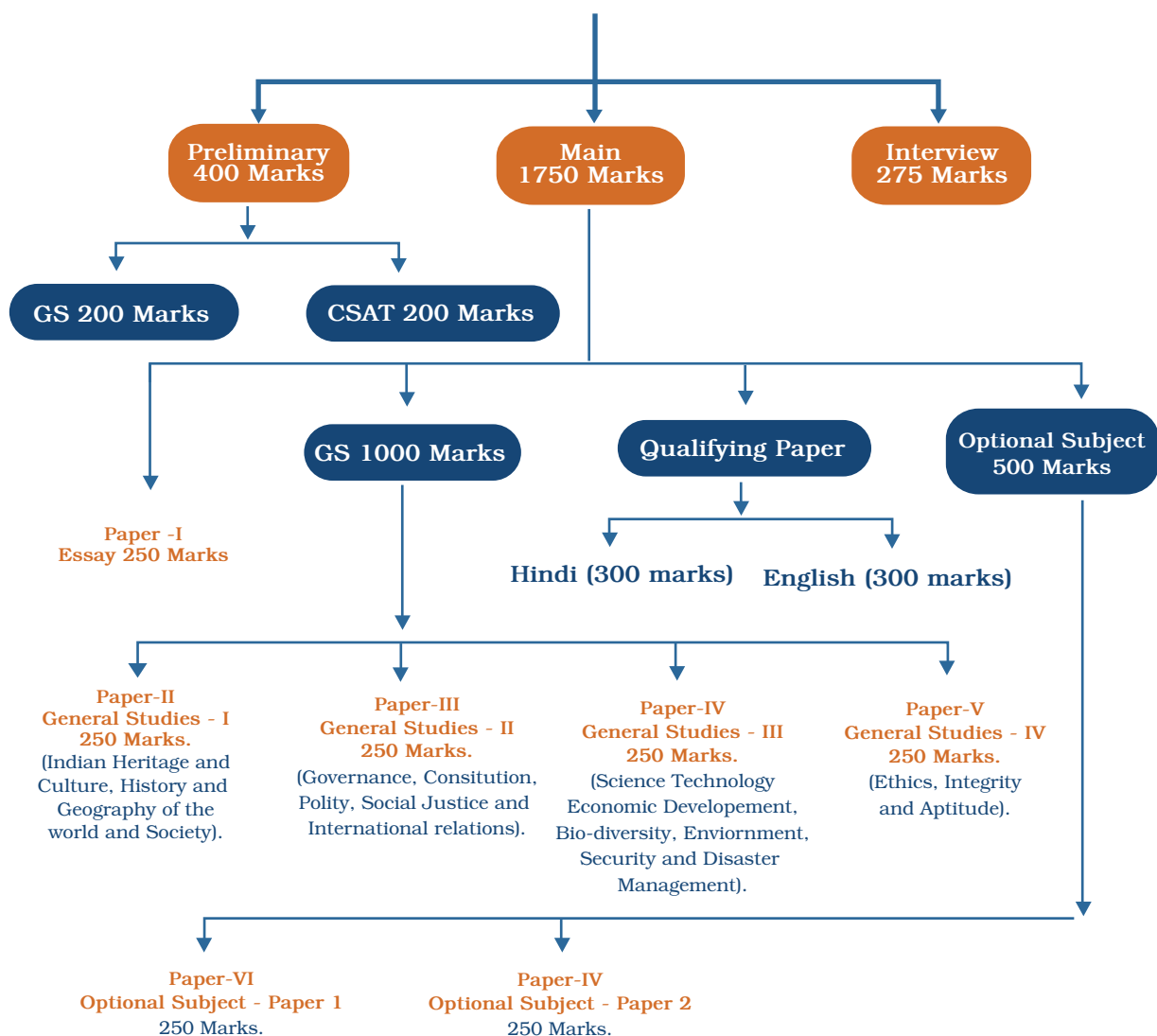

GENERAL STUDIES MAIN

The Main Examination is designed to evaluate the overall analytical attributes of candidates, rather than entirely on the range of their information and reminiscence. The nature and standards of the questions in the General Studies papers (Paper II to Paper V) are prepared in such a manner that a well-educated person will be able to answer them without any specialized study. The questions will be formed to test an aspirant's general awareness on a variety of subjects, which will be applicable in Civil Services. The questions are likely to test the candidate's basic understanding of all relevant issues, and ability to analyze, and take a view on various socio-economic goals, objectives, and demands. The candidates must give appropriate, significant, and condensed answers.



PAPER-I (ESSAY)

Writing is a combination of one's potential and aptitude, but essay writing for the Civil Services Examination requires something more. It requires a grasp over current events and information for writing accurately and adequately for three long hours. The UPSC essay writing wants to ensure the writing skill of selected students. The purpose of the Essay writing Paper was reintroduced in 1993. There are no language barriers which could test the writing abilities of aspirants. Therefore, the Satish Chandra Committee recommended a compulsory paper in essay writing of 200 marks, either in English or in any one of the 'Indian Languages' included in the eighth schedule of the constitution. Committee beliefs, Mains examination will bring out not only the aspirant's linguistic skills but also his proficiency for comprehensive and critical analysis, and quality of his/her integrated thinking, comprehensive ideas, and transparency of expression.

To ensure uniformity of standards, the evaluation of the answer scripts of the Essay Paper should take into account:

- Comprehension
- Innovation of thought
- Transparency of expression
- Integrated thinking with comprehending ideas

In order to overcome the lack of uniformity of standards, evaluation of the answer scripts in the answer paper will be done by two independent examiners. In this system, the marks scored by an aspirant should be aspiration for two scores
